E-Mail Contact for Service of Process upon Insurance Companies

In response to the statutory change to R.I. Gen. Laws § 27-2-14 effective July 18, 2017 and, to further the Department's commitment to improving efficiencies, the Department will cease mailing copies of services of process and will instead send these documents electronically via email to the "Service of Process Contact" on file for each foreign insurance company and insurance related licensee.

The Department will accept service of process on behalf of licensed foreign insurers, reciprocal exchanges and interinsurers, fraternal benefit societies, and nonresident reinsurance intermediaries in accordance with [230-RICR-20-60-10](#) (Insurance Regulation 114). This Alert does not apply to those insurers or entities for which the Department is not authorized to accept service of process in accordance with Section 6 of [230-RICR-20-60-10](#) (Insurance Regulation 114).

All foreign insurers and insurance related licensees subject to [230-RICR-20-60-10](#) (Insurance Regulation 114) are hereby required to provide the Department with an e-mail address for the "Service of Process Contact" to ensure timely and accurate delivery of services of process served upon the insurance commissioner. The following Service of Process Contact information must be sent electronically to Debra Almeida at Debra.Almeida@dbr.ri.gov by January 8, 2018.
