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Rhode Island Workers' Compensation 2008 RI Medical Fee Schedule Surgical Fees Adjustment

At the request of the Department of Labor and Training, this Bulletin is hereby issued to advise insurers that there was an error made in printing the 2008 surgical fees. Since the cost of living allowance adjustment was not included, the fees were less than the intended reimbursement.

The Department of Labor and Training's publisher, Rising Medical Solutions, has contacted anyone who purchased the fee schedule and provided the correct adjusted fees to them. These adjusted fees are effective as of July 1, 2008. If a provider or insurer has not been contacted, please e-mail Matt Carey at mcarey@dlt.ri.gov.

To receive the proper adjustment for services provided, physicians should submit invoices for the difference between the incorrect fee and the adjusted fee and insurers and self-insured employers must pay these invoices within 60 days of receipt.

Physicians and insurers or self-insured employers may agree to an alternative method of reimbursement.
